Ghost Fever Grips the World

In early 2024, the website whoyagonnacall.org was launched by Bob Anderson, Ryan Espin, Peter Natale, and myself (later adding the incredible Joe Ricciardelli to the admin team). The page is



a directory for Ghostbusters fan franchises around the world. Our mission is simple: To be a hub for Ghostbusters cosplayers to find their local team (or help launch one for others to find) and to be a resource for anyone to easily contact the group closest to them and understand what they offer.

No longer do Ghostbusters fan franchises need to rely solely on faceless social media empires to get their names and missions out there. With 280+ teams already listed across 20 countries (with more support on the way), there's no better time than now to find or list a franchise on whoyagonnacall.org.

More Than A Movie: The Evolution of Ghostbusters Day

On June 8, 1984, Ghostbusters hit the big screen, launching a supernaturally spectacular comedy that captivated the world and left us forever asking: "Who ya gonna call?" Forty-one years later, that rallying cry still echoes through a vibrant fandom who answers quite loudly- "Ghostbusters!" A fandom that celebrates its love for the franchise equally as loud—especially on Ghostbusters Day.

What began as a way to mark the film's anniversary has become a global celebration of fandom, community, and charity. For the

past five years, fans have gathered at New York's iconic Hook & Ladder 8 firehouse, Ghostbusters HQ, to celebrate with an event hosted by the Buffalo Ghostbusters. These fans know that bustin' doesn't just make you feel good—it does good.

"Ghostbusters Day is a celebration of the fandom, a reason for all of us to get together and do what Ghostbusters do best—help others," says Christopher Burns Jr., who highlights the charity-driven core of the event. The celebration began as a spontaneous idea during a late-night chat session: replace the firehouse's damaged Ghostbusters II sign with

a replica. That idea quickly gained momentum.

Brent Hollingsworth recalls launching a GoFundMe while Dan Liberg contacted the firehouse. Soon after, the team reached out to Ghost Corps, who stepped in to donate the Hollywood Collectibles sign. With those funds freed up, the Buffalo team commissioned the full-size sign that now proudly hangs outside Hook & Ladder 8 24/7, a permanent tribute for fans and tourists alike.

Haunted New York

Oh, hey there reader! I'm Bob Anderson from the paranormal podcast, "Bob After Dark." Did you know that the film you're celebrating has its roots in real life paranormal investigation? Since he was a kid, Dan Aykroyd was

surrounded by talks of the supernatural due to his family's interest. Even the character Gozer was inspired by the Enfield Poltergeist case. So, I teamed up with New York City Ghostbusters member, Dan Hoffman (who also is a paranormal investigator) to help come up with several spots around New

York that have ghost stories attached.

Suffolk County Hauntings: Camp Hero – Government Cover-ups and Fourth-Dimensional Creatures? You Bet.

More Than A Movie (cont)

Dan Liberg explains how that first success revealed the event’s greater potential. “We realized this whole initiative had bigger potential than just a one-off,” he says. Thus began an annual tradition, with the firehouse helping to select a new beneficiary each year.

The team, along with ghoulishly great graphics extraordinaire, Eric Christenson, creates exclusive merchandise including shirts, patches, coins, and more to raise funds. “It’s not just making an attractive design,” Eric explains, “It’s making a design with purpose.”

The event has drawn support from across the Ghostbusters fandom. ECTO-1NJ and NYC Ghostbusters regularly bring their ECTO vehicles and lead tours. Artist Chris Sorrentino of ReelGhostbusters hands out free prints every year. “The support is tremendous,” Liberg says.

The celebration has also welcomed franchise insiders like Eldo Ray Estes, Joe

Cirillo, John Rothman, and the Alessi Brothers. One year, even Harold Ramis’s wife attended. “She said, ‘He would’ve loved to be here,’” Dan recalls. “And I told her, ‘He is... he’s here.’”

Ghostbusters Day means different things to different people. For Brent, it’s that “late night idea we thought wouldn’t go anywhere.” For Christopher, it’s family: “I get to experience the day raising money for a great cause with 1,500+ friends.” For Eric, it’s about celebrating the passion and connection within the fandom.

What started as a tribute to a film has evolved into something bigger—a celebration of unity, joy, and giving back. Ghostbusters Day isn’t just about remembering a movie. It’s about honoring its spirit: that when people come together, they can face anything—even a giant marshmallow man.

Haunted NY (cont)

Let’s set the scene: it’s 1942. The U.S. Government decides that Long Island might be a prime target for German U-boats, so what do they do? Build a military base that looks like a sleepy New England fishing town. Painted-on windows, a gym disguised as a church—it’s the world’s weirdest game of hide-and-seek.

Originally named Fort Hero, after Major General Andrew Hero Jr. (yes, really), the site served as a coastal defense post during WWII. After a brief closure, it reopened during the Cold War for reasons the government would rather not discuss at dinner parties.

But here’s where it gets juicy: enter The Montauk Project. Rumors of top-secret experiments, time travel, psychic kids, and a cuddly little fourth-dimensional nightmare creature the locals call “Junior.” Sound familiar? It should. This is the real-life inspiration behind Netflix’s Stranger Things. Cue the synth music.

Nassau County Hauntings: Theodore Roosevelt’s House – The Summer White House Gets Chilly.

In 1880, Teddy Roosevelt—yes, that Roosevelt—bought his uncle’s estate and turned it into a glorious 22-room mansion (he added a bonus room in 1905. Power move.) Sagamore Hill would become known as the “Summer White House,” and by all accounts, Teddy loved it there.

So much so, some say he never

left. Visitors to the estate have reported ghostly sightings of Roosevelt himself, especially in his beloved trophy room and office. His favorite rocking chair? It still rocks... without him in it.

Coincidence? Or one Rough Rider who refuses to ride off into the sunset?

NYC Hauntings: Merchant’s House Museum – Where the Past Refuses to Check Out.

Built in 1832 by Joseph Brewster and bought just three years later by Seabury Tredwell, this Manhattan townhouse remained in the family for nearly a century. In 1936, it was converted into a museum—and that’s when the strange reports began.

Meet Gertrude. Born in an upstairs bedroom in 1840, she lived her entire life in the house and passed away there in 1933. And by all accounts? She’s still there. Staff and visitors alike report whispers, footsteps, cold spots, and the distinct feeling of not being alone.

She’s the house’s last tenant—and not in a hurry to break her lease.

Fandom with Purpose

Answering the Call for Hospitalized Kids

In 2021, the nonprofit Starlight Children’s Foundation, with its mission to deliver happiness to hospitalized kids and their families, caught the attention of the Los Angeles Ghostbusters (LAGB). As they learned more about Starlight’s work, the LAGB empathized with the challenges hospitalized children face, including battling anxiety, boredom, and pain. They couldn’t just stand around — they had to do something.

And that’s what they did! They suited up for hospitalized kids, hosting creative fundraisers to deliver Starlight programs, including Ghostbusters-themed Starlight Hospital Gowns and

Toys, to kids nationwide.

With these crucial resources, kids received play-based care that helped them feel brave like their favorite heroes, and found comfort to cope and ease anxiety throughout their hospital stay.

Since then, with the support of Ghost Corps and Sony Pictures Entertainment, the LAGB and Ghostbusters fan groups from coast to coast have teamed up to raise over \$95,000 for Starlight!

“When a child puts on a Ghostbusters-themed Starlight Hospital Gown, they’re not just a patient—they become a hero ready to take on their hospital stay with determination and bravery,” said Adam Garone, CEO of Starlight. “Thanks to the incredible generosity of Ghostbuster groups

nationwide, these gowns unleash the healing power of play, giving kids a renewed sense of optimism, resilience, and courage.”

“Ecto-citing” Hospital Visits

National Reach, Local Impact: Ghostbusters groups have impacted 71 hospitals across 29 states.

Ghostbusters-themed Hospital Gowns: To date, 4,000 gowns have been funded and distributed, featuring two official Ghostbusters-themed designs.

Ghostbusters Toys: Hundreds of kids have received Ghostbusters toys through hospital deliveries and the Starlight Families program.

A “Specter-cular” Impact

Local Ghostbusters groups in California, Colorado, Florida, Texas, and Indiana engaged with kids at eight children’s hospitals, delivering Ghostbusters-themed toys and hospital gowns, along with talent from the films, including actress Mckenna Grace and filmmakers Jason Reitman and Gil Kenan.

“There’s a reason why we like cosplay. We want to be the characters we fall in love with on the big

screen. In the same way they bring us together, they can bring us together to do good. Frankly, that’s what makes me so impressed with what Starlight has done, not only in the Ghostbusters universe, but across so many comic books and movie franchises. I really want to encourage you, if you love a film, if you love a character, it’s an excuse to do good.” - Jason Reitman

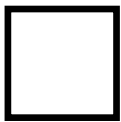
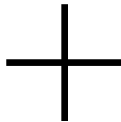
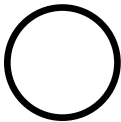
Lucky Ghost: The Slor – A strange creature that only an inventive mind like yours could control.



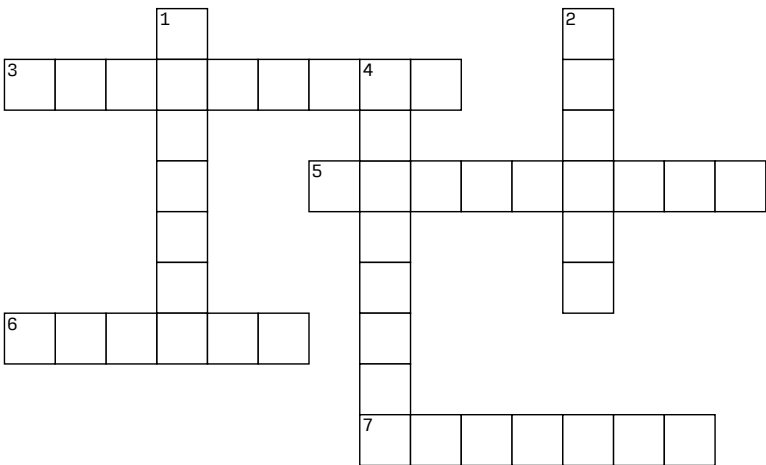
